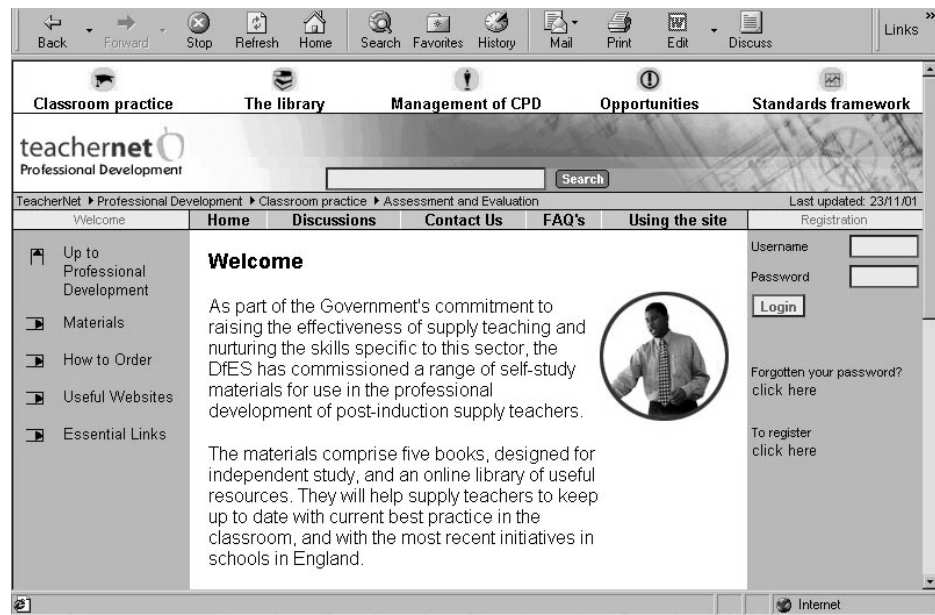


Guidance on using the website

A website, giving information and offering support to supply teachers, has been developed in conjunction with these materials. You will find it within the Professional Development section of the DfES **teachernet** site at www.teachernet.gov.uk.

The website consists of five interlinking pages:

Welcome page

This is the gateway to the other pages and shows a menu on the left-hand side of the screen to help you find other pages within the supply teachers website. On the right-hand side of the screen are instructions that you may use if you wish to take advantage of other facilities within the DfES general website, eg. specialist discussion groups.

Materials

In this section of the website, you can find information about the structure and content of the written materials as well as sample extracts from each book. To view an extract, select the 'view sample document' option within this section.

Adobe Acrobat Reader™ is required to view the sample extract. To access this download, simply use the easy-to-follow instructions found within this section of the website. Once you have downloaded and installed Adobe Acrobat Reader™ you will be able to read all Adobe PDF files. Click on 'view sample document' to access the sample extracts within this section of the website.
